BRECON MARKET FAIRDAY REPORT – NOVEMBER 5th 2016

BLUEBERRY MAKES 1350 GUINEAS!!

Once again Brecon fair day Sale attracted a full ring of buyers from all over the UK and over seas. The entry of 311 horses was the best we have seen for several years. Topping the whole sale and the non Welsh was a Gypsy Cob Filly Foal sold at 1350 guineas to C O Conner. In the non Welsh section several cob foals made over 200 guineas with the top price Shetland making 420 guineas from S Morgans. An Appaloosa mare made 1000 guineas.

WELSH SECTIONS

It was pleasing to have so many show quality animals forward. Topping the Section A section was the Blaenau Stud with lot 78 Blaenau Faris a 4 year old by Blaenau Viplin at 460 guineas selling to Jonathan and Clare Batt of the Abergavenny Stud. The Champion foal was also from the Blaenau Stud and this was lot 74 Blaenau Vacum. Top price Welsh Mountain foal was from G Owens for lot 33 Trehwfa Tokyo selling to J Mckie at 200 guineas. 89% of the Section A section was cleared out of 146 offered for sale. With many foals making over 80 guineas.

The Welsh Cob Mares were in a strong demand with lot 183 Brynthion Emanuel making 1000 guineas. Llwynhywel OMG, a chestnut yearling colt sold at 700 guineas. Lot 170 Caederwen Heulwen who is by Cascob Flash Jack sold at 900 guineas to J Price, Courtway Stud, Clyro. The Welsh Cobs averaged 350 guineas right through with a 90% clearance.

19 Welsh animals sold over seas, which was very pleasing. I feel that this sale is going from strength to strength with your support.
