## **BRECON MARKET SHOW POTENTIAL SALE SATURDAY 11<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2017**

Brecon Market offered probably the best entry of show potential cattle very seen at this annual sale, over 100 cattle were forward, mainly from noted Welsh producers however several new vendors from the Midlands and also the West Country supported the sale.

The quality of stock was exceptional, there were 11 classes all of which offered some tremendous cattle that had the potential to go on and win any fatstock show.

The Judge Blair Dufton from Scotland commented that it was the best show he has seen and enjoyed the challenge of judging such a yard of quality stock.

The supreme Champion went to PL & OJ Watkins from Hay-On-Wye who had never been to the sale before. They had a quality heifer being Lot 1 Little Miss P, being the first lot of the day sold to £5000 and was purchased by the judge.

Reserve Champion was lot 53 bred and exhibited by JM & AM Lewis, sold for £3000 to Mr Mike Rowlands, Dolwen, while they also sold a steer lot 54 to £2300 to Messrs Pisdley from the West Country.

The steers topped at £4100 for a superb Limousin steer from Messrs DS, DA & P Brute, he won his class and was purchased by Mr C J Harris, Little Lambert.

There was also a superb run of cattle from G Jones & Co, Dolderwen who sold 4 cattle to average £2650 topping at £3100 for lot 88 a steer and also £3100 for a heifer lot 86 which was purchased by P & S Sellers, Thorpe Tilney Farm.

The second highest price heifer came from Messrs T Jones & Co of Bailea making £3350 for lot 70 My Grace and they averaged £2250 on 4 young cattle.

Over 19 cattle made over £2000. The steers averaged £1556 and the heifers £1752 which would have been considerably up on last year.

The sale was well sponsored with over £1200 of prize money including the support of the Farmers Guardian.
