## LUDLOW MARKET STORE SALE FRIDAY 27<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2017

### STORE CATTLE – 498

An excellent entry of 498 head of cattle met with a solid trade from start to finish. Several buyers had travelled from away looking for stock as supplies tighten in other parts of the country.

Once again young bulls were a highlight of the sale with bulls topping at 296.0p/kg and average 203.0p/kg. This is to include dairy breed sorts and older ones. Vendors should be mindful of ages when grouping stock and FABBL is more essential than ever.

Steers topped at 263.0p/kg and averaged 192.0p/kg. Several customers restocking yards after sales after Christmas and the first signs of men putting grazing sorts together.

Heifers again had an excellent following with several good runs of younger suckled sorts, these peaked at 297.0p/kg overall the heifers averaged 185.0p/kg.

The cattle trade is very good. If you have some to sell please think about selling sooner rather than later.

## **STORE SHEEP – 3,645**

An excellent entry of store lambs met an exceptional trade for all sizes and shapes. If you have still got store sheep sell them now whilst the trade is as good as it is. Strong lambs to £78.00 and average for all sorts £58.20.

In lamb ewes found a keen following with plenty of customers competing for every pen. In lamb yearlings sold to £142.00 but the trade of the day were aged ewes selling to £152.00. More in lamb ewes needed.

## **CALVES & WEANLINGS – 20**

A good show of rearing calves matched with a strong following. Topping at £410 for a Charolais bull calf, averaging £270 for all sorts and heifers topping at £305 averaging £240.

Weanlings, predominately bulls, topped at £400 for a Welsh Black, Holstein Friesians to £195. Heifers to £400 for a British Blue. More could have easily been sold.
