McCartyneys report a successful sale of live and dead farming stock at Pool Farm, Llanfihangle Nant Melan, New Radnor on Saturday 12th October on behalf of Ivor and Angela Davies.

The flock of hardy hill sheep readily sold with a top of £80 for yearling ewes, £77 for two year old ewes, £79 for three year olds and stock ewes to £60.

Store lambs were well sold with Texel cross making £65 and Suffolk cross making £65 with the general run being from £52 - £58. Suffolk rams sold to £280 for two year old and £275 for three year old. Texel 3year old ram made £325 and £305 and Blue-Faced Leicester stock ram selling to £180.

Silage bales sold to £21 and round bale hay sold to £24. Grass keep for 10 weeks sold to £24.50 per acre and averaged £22.60 per acre.

A small sale of implements were well sold with a Vicon spinner at £380, turnover crate at £360, bale spike at £180, PZ mower at £410, sheep handling race at £730, snacker at £400, Ivor Williams stock trailer £2,800, MF 590 tractor R reg £2,600, Universal 640 tractor and loader X reg £4,100, MF 565 X reg tractor £3,500, New Holland TS100 02 reg tractor (11,000 hours) £11, 500 and quad bike at £1,750.
